The successful applicant will be required to cover the area named above in teaching and research.

Appointment requirements are governed by Article 100 of the Berlin Higher Education Act (Berliner Hochschulgesetz).

The successful candidate will have an outstanding track record of international university teaching and research and have experience in acquiring funding for, and carrying out, sponsored research. Teaching and research should focus on Religious Studies from a cultural and historical–anthropological perspective, including ancient religious history and its transformation and reception in particular.

The successful candidate will be expected to contribute research oriented courses to the Institute's curricula, as well as work with colleagues on interdisciplinary research associations such as the Excellence Cluster TOPOI, the Collaborative Research Center 980 Episteme in Motion. Transfer of Knowledge from the Ancient World to the Early Modern Period, the Berlin Graduate School of Ancient Studies (BerGSAS), the Berliner Antike–Kolleg and the Interdisziplinäres Forum Gender und Diversity Studies. She or he will be prepared to engage in existing and upcoming cross–departmental research associations and acquire third party funds.

Applications quoting the **reference W3Relwiss** should include a CV, copies of all certificates of academic qualification, a list of publications, evidence of teaching competence (such as courses previously taught) as well as of involvement in ongoing and future research endeavors, joint research projects and externally funded projects. If applicable, applications should also include information on industrial cooperations, inventions/patents and spin–offs.
