

We would like to invite contributions to a 'Teaching and Learning' panel for the BASR annual conference hosted by The Open University in Milton Keynes on the 3-5 September 2014. Contributions can relate to either of the two conference themes: they can discuss how the theme 'Religion, art and performance' is reflected in or relevant to teaching and learning, or consider other 'cutting edge' debates within the scholarship of teaching. Contributions can either be in the form of 20 minute long oral presentations (followed by 10 mins discussion) or shorter discussion papers (followed by a longer discussion). Paper proposals should provide a title, abstract of no more than 250 words and the presenter's name and institutional affiliation.

We would also like to invite contributions to an installation of posters and presentations (prezis, images, objects, film clips and other modes of presentation) of student research and work on the theme of 'The products of student learning', which will be displayed at the conference.
