

PhD Studentship in Mission Studies

Leeds Trinity University is pleased to invite applications from excellent graduates for a full-time PhD Studentship in the area of Mission Studies.

The successful applicant would be supervised by [Professor Kirsteen Kim](#), editor of the journal *Mission Studies*, published by Brill Academic Publishers in collaboration with the International Association for Mission Studies. He/she would also be appointed Editorial Assistant of *Missions Studies* and support the publication of the journal in this role for on average one day per week.

Funding

The award will include a fee waiver plus £6,000 p.a. for 4 years.

Entry Requirements

Applicants must have, or expect to obtain, a masters degree in a related discipline. Exceptional candidates with a first-class honours degree will also be considered.

Candidates whose first language is not English must provide evidence that their English language is sufficient to meet the specific demands of their study and be at the level expected for editing work. Candidates as a minimum will be expected to have obtained one of the following qualifications:

- the British Council IELTS with a score of 7.0 (with not less than 6.5 in any component);
- the internet based TOEFL (iBT) with 100 overall (with not less than 24 in listening, 24 in reading, 26 in speaking and 26 in writing).
