

## FIRST CALL

### EIGHTH INTERNATIONAL MEETING ON SOCIO-RELIGIOUS STUDIES

***Dialogue among religions as strategy and means for peace***  
*Havana, July 12-15, 2016*

The Department of Socio-religious Studies of the Center for Psychological and Sociological Research (CIPS) of the Ministry of Science, Technology and the Environment of Cuba calls scholars on religion, academics and religious believers to participate in the EIGHTH INTERNATIONAL MEETING ON SOCIO-RELIGIOUS STUDIES, sponsored by Comité Catholique contre la Faim et pour le Développement (CCFD) and the Oscar Arnulfo Romero Group of Reflection and Solidarity, that will be held on July 12-15, at the Cuban Anthropology Institute, in historic old Havana.

This traditional event will take place at a time when humankind is facing serious issues in the social, economic, political, ethical and cultural relations fields, with no immediate solution prospects, in which, as it is known, religion has a growing impact.

At the same time, the critical world conditions exert a particular impact on religion, bringing about a relationship between changes in both scenarios. Taking the former into account, presentations, panels, lectures and videos dealing with the following topics will be presented and discussed:

- *Fundamentalisms as a cause of violence and religious intolerance*
- *Reshaping of religious spaces in the first decades of the 21st century.*
- *Poverty, social inequity and discrimination as conflict sources*
- *Role of religions in the environmental and educational crisis currently being faced by humankind*

At the meeting a workshop on ***“Religion, religiosity and culture”*** will take place in commemoration of the tenth anniversary of the death of Dr. Jorge Ramírez Calzadilla, founder and head of the Department of Socio-religious Studies up to his passing away in 2006.

The experience gained at the seven previous meetings--- held every three years from 1995 to 2013---, attended by scholars and specialists from all continents, including well-known personalities who study religion from a social sciences approach, is conducive to meaningful dialogues from different approaches, in an atmosphere of scientific rigor and respect of the opinions of others.
