

Call for Papers about Peoples Temple and Jonestown

Nova Religio, the quarterly journal on alternative and emergent religions published by University of California Press (<http://nr.ucpress.edu/>), has scheduled a special issue devoted to Peoples Temple and Jonestown. Articles are sought that address the significance of the group and its end in a variety of ways: treatment in popular culture; fine arts; theoretical developments post-Jonestown; legacy of Jonestown for NRM studies; Peoples Temple as a communal organization; ideology of the group; feminist perspectives; Jim Jones as prophet; race and racism in the Temple and in society; comparative studies of Jonestown and Peoples Temple; effect on Guyana; and any new issues arising that would be of interest to *Nova Religio* readers. Deadlines: Abstracts of 150 words are due by 28 February 2017; notification of accepted abstracts will be made by 31 March 2017; completed papers no longer than 10,000 words (including endnotes) are due 15 September 2017.
