Research in the Social Scientific Study of Religion (RSSSR) is an annual series by Brill that publishes original research related to religion in the fields of sociology and psychology. We are looking for an editor to work alongside Professor Ralph Hood Jr., who is a psychologist of religion based in the USA. Ideally we would like to appoint someone who works in the Sociology of Religion and who is based in the UK or elsewhere Europe. The role involves working the co-editor, editorial board, and guest editors of special sections to manage the peer-review and publication of around 15-20 papers per year. RSSSR volume 29 is due out later this year, and we already have material planned for volume 30, due in 2019.
