

Secularism and Nonreligion — Invitation for New Editors

The open access, peer-review journal *Secularism and Nonreligion* is inviting applications for two new executive editors. We welcome applications from people in all stages of their academic career, including early career researchers. Research experience within the social scientific study of nonreligion and secularity or previous editorial experience is essential.

Secularism and Nonreligion is an interdisciplinary journal published with the aim of advancing research on various aspects of 'the secular.' The journal is interested in contributions from primarily social scientific disciplines, including: psychology, sociology, political science, women's studies, history, economics, geography, demography, anthropology, public health, and religious studies. Contributions from neuroscience, computer science, biology, and medicine will also be considered. Articles published in the journal focus on the secular at one of three levels: the micro or individual level, the meso or institutional level, or the macro or national and international levels. Articles explore all aspects of what it means to be secular at any of the above levels, what the lives of nonreligious individuals are like, and the interactions between secularity and other aspects of the world.
