

42nd annual UK conference in Implicit Religion (formerly known as the Denton Conference) 17-19 May 2019

The 42nd UK Implicit Religion Conference will be held at Bishop Grosseteste University, Lincoln from the 19th - 21st May. The cost will be £180. The theme for this year is “Religion and the Encounter”. The Edward Bailey lecture will be delivered by Dr Tim Jenkins (Cambridge) with the title for the lecture being, “Encounters with Aliens: research into images of life elsewhere.”

The Implicit Religion conference is open to all regardless of educational level or affiliation, race, gender, class, ethnicity or visa status. We actively encourage participation by undergraduate and post graduate students, those who are underemployed within academia, under-represented groups in scholarship and parents of young children. The conference is based on the premise of a conference, with presenters submitting their paper in advance, speaking to it briefly and then the audience discussion.
