Public Lecture Alevi Kurds and the Transformation of Sacred Space: How 'Kemeré Duzgi' became 'Düzgün Baba Cemevi' Ahmet Kerim Gültekin (Philipp Schwartz Fellowship, Leipzig University)

Focusing on the Dersim region, this presentation by Philipp Schwartz Fellow Ahmet Kerim Gültekin will examine the transformation processes of practices related to sacred places in Kurdish Alevism. The lecture will be preceded by an introduction by Markus Dreßler on the situation of oppositional scholars in contemporary Turkey.
